TEACHING TIPS...

Affirming children for who they are and what they are able to do, can create lasting positive impressions. Even just small affirmations can have a big impact.

- Greet each child by name.
- Encourage a child's creativity, "I like how you put the bear's eyes there, that is very creative".
- Compliment a child for any amount of effort "thank you for not giving up" or "thank you for letting your classmates listen to the story".
- Have the children recognize their classmates for doing something positive. Say a quick "good job" and make sure every child is recognized for something. "Good job to Ryan for cleaning up", "Good job to Ana for sharing with Alice". The children can repeat "good job".
- Remember that every child has special gifts, has certain limitations, and deserves to be accepted and appreciated for the unique person that they are.
